RESOLUTION 2023-30

The Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in regular session at the Miami Township Civic Center on July 18, 2023, with the following members present: Mark Schulte, Ken Tracy and Mary Makley Wolff.

A motion was made to adopt the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DESTRUCTION OF SURPLUS, UNNEEDED OR OBSOLESCENT PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NECESSARY FOR TOWNSHIP USE, DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 505.10(7) of the Ohio Revised Code permits the Board of Township Trustees (the "Board") to dispose of unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property which it determines to no longer be necessary for township use; and

WHEREAS, the Board seeks to dispose of, or sell by internet auction, the unneeded or obsolescent personal property no longer necessary for township use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio by authority of Section 505.10(D) of the Ohio Revised Code, as follows:

- **SECTION 1:** The Board determines that the surplus equipment listed on <u>Exhibit A</u> is no longer of value and service to Miami Township and authorizes it to be disposed of, or sold by internet auction on Govdeals.com.
- **SECTION 2:** The Board does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to Section 504.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, and authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading, declaring an emergency.
- **SECTION 3**: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, welfare and morals of Miami Township specifically in order to allow for the property to be disposed of or sold at the earliest date to maximize the value to be obtained for its sale, and this legislation shall take

effect immediately upon its passage by the affirmative vote of all members of the Board.

SECTION 4: That this Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
